Student Academic Work Expectations

- 3 - 4 hours of academic work per day
- 10/11th Grade students must complete 60 mins of language a day
- 11th Grade students must complete at least 90 mins of official SAT prep through Khan Academy per week.
- 9-11th Grade students must complete at least 30 - 45 minutes of Khan academy per day for Math
- 1.5 hours of Teacher/Fellow Meetings per day (Monday - Friday)
- Scheduled 1:1 meetings on Friday
- Students must attend all scheduled Teacher/Fellow meetings per day to receive seat time attendance for the day
- If you miss your scheduled time you must email the teacher to request a different time (at discretion of the teacher's schedule). Email must be cc'd to Acardoso@greatoakscharter.org and cpellegrino@greatoakscharter.org
- All assigned work must be completed prior to returning to receive credit.
