High School Student Expectations

- 3 - 4 hours of academic work per day
- 10/11th Grade students must complete 60 mins of language a day
- 9-11th Grade students must complete at least 30 minutes of Khan academy per day
- 1.5 hours of Teacher/Fellow Meetings per day (Monday - Friday)
- Scheduled 1:1 meetings on Friday
- Watch Mini-Lesson Video prior to scheduled meeting with Teacher/Fellow
- Meet with teachers in groups of 4-6 at scheduled times
- Split into either Group A or Group B
- A groups meet with Humanities (Monday & Wednesday) B groups meet with Humanities on (Tuesday & Thursday); B Groups meet with STEM (Monday & Wednesday), A Groups meet with STEM (Tuesday & Thursday)
- Students must attend all scheduled Teacher/Fellow meetings per day to receive seat time attendance for the day
- If you miss your scheduled time you must email the teacher to request a different time (at discretion of the teacher's schedule). Email must be cc'd to Acardoso@greatoakscharter.org and cpellegrino@greatoakscharter.org
- During all video conferencing, you must conduct yourself in an appropriate manner.
This includes:
 - Setting your laptop and camera in an appropriate space (home office or table)
 - Wear appropriate clothing
- All assigned work must be completed prior to returning to receive credit.
