

Uniform Policy

We are a uniform school. Our students are expected to wear the approved uniform items detailed below. Students are expected to wear their approved uniform Monday, Wednesday Thursday and Friday, and are allowed to dress down on that Tuesday with the guidelines below:

Dress Down Criteria
